 Development Director Ryn Moravec provided information about Stride Community Health's mobile health team that provides outreach in Aurora and at the microcommunity at the Denver/Englewood border. Stride's goal is to reduce hospitalization and Emergency Room visits by offering care to individuals experiencing homelessness and at schools with low-income families with a mobile health vehicle and through backpack street medicine.
